**5. Application Review:**

A. Review Botox permit application: The applicant's course failed to meet requirements of Admin Rule 20-02-01-11. Dr. Evanoff moved to deny the permit. Motion seconded by Dr. Petersen. (RCV): Marsh, yes; Dohm, yes; Mehlhoff, yes; Keim, yes; Petersen, yes; Goebel, yes; Evanoff, yes. Motion carried, 7-0.

B. Review sedation permit application: The applicant applied for moderate parenteral sedation. The site evaluator had several concerns. The applicant meets the educational requirements. A second site evaluation was recommended to address the chief concern, dosage and recovery/dismissal times (Aldrete score) when using respiratory depressant drugs as well as concerns regarding the facility. Dr. Goebel moved to deny the permit application based on the site evaluation. Motion seconded by Dr. Evanoff. (RCV): Marsh, yes; Dohm, yes; Mehlhoff, yes; Keim, yes; Petersen, yes; Goebel, yes; Evanoff, yes. Motion carried, 7-0.

C. RDA renewal applicant: The Board has a reasonable basis to believe a renewal applicant may have neglected to report charges/convictions. Dr. Evanoff will send a letter requesting information and explanation from the RDA.
