



Nitrous Oxide/Oxygen Inhalation Analgesia Administration Certification Course

This course will prepare the dental assistant or dental hygienist for the safe, effective administration of nitrous oxide/oxygen inhalation sedation. Participants will be required to administer three nitrous oxide inhalation sedations as outlined in the Minnesota and North Dakota Dental Practice Acts, using fail-safe anesthesia equipment capable of positive pressure respirations. Participants will earn **12 CE hours** - a combination of didactic hours of outside study and lecture and hands on hours of supervised clinical experience.

**PLEASE NOTE: Pregnant women are not eligible to participate in this course.
